**ACADEMICS:** Full attention was paid to academic work this half of the term. Teaching and learning process went on smoothly for all subjects. The SSS3 and JSS3 students have successfully written the 2013 WASSCE/NECO JSCE. The SSS3 students will commence the NECO SSCE on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 while the state (Gateway) JSCE for JSS3 Students will start on 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2013.

**COMPETITIONS:** The school took part in some competitions this half term. We are happy to inform you that:

(a) Two of our students, Aliyu Emmanuel (SS2/Acting Headboy) and Olawale Yisau (SS2) emerged winners in the 2013 annual competition organized by the Gifted Child Foundation and thus, they will be representing Nigeria in Ghana later this year.

(b) Three of our students, Adubi Paul (Chemistry), Aliyu Emmanuel (Physics) and Ibrahim Bilal (Basic science) emerged amongst the state champions in the 2013 Olympiad organized by National Mathematics Centre, Abuja,

(c) The two students that represented the school in this year 2013 state organized Children's Day essay competition amongst secondary schools came 2<sup>nd</sup> position.

Aside these, the school hosted this year 2013 Mathematics competition, organized by the Discovery Help Foundation having won the last edition in 2012. 50 private and public secondary schools across Ogun state attended the competition.
